A Weekly Reflection

Slow Down! I say it a lot. My daughter, Lulu, talks so fast, half the time I can't understand what she is saying. Hunter runs inside, down the hall and out of sight before I can even utter this short phrase. I even shout it at the cars traveling too fast on my street. What is the purpose? I say it to aid in communication. I say it to keep my children safe. I say it to calm an upset child. Sometimes, I am given the quick "alright, alright," or blown off with a sigh of total annoyance. Sometimes, I am completely ignored; however, sometimes it works. A deep breath, a moment of stillness in my arms, even a smile can take an end-of-the-world moment and make it calm, more focused.

This time of year, as the days grow shorter, the air cooler and the outside gets ready to hibernate, I find myself wanting to slow down as well. ADVENT AND CHRISTMAS AT ST. MARY'S

Advent is the first season of the new church year, when we prepare for Christmas, the coming of the incarnate Christ into the world. Because this is a **special season of waiting and watching**, you will notice different hymns and prayers in our Sunday services, and we will celebrate Holy Eucharist at both services throughout Advent and Christmas. Some other highlights of Advent and Christmas at St. Mary's include:

- ❖ **Evening Prayer on Advent Wednesdays** (December 7, 14, and 21) at **5:45 p.m.** in Little St. Mary's.
- ❖ **Adult Forums on Advent Sundays in December** (December 4, 11, and 18) at 10 a.m. will focus on the **Advent gospels** and what they can reveal to us about the meaning of Christ coming into the world over 2,000 years ago – and now. Join Weezie Blanchard and Bob Hetherington for this opportunity to deepen your understanding of Advent and enrich your faith.
- ❖ **Mary at the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts.** Rector (and long ago VMFA docent) Weezie Blanchard continues **her seasonal series** of looking for the holy in the outstanding collections of the VMFA. - ❖ **Lessons and Carols on Sunday, December 18** at **5:30 p.m.** in New St. Mary's. Following in the footsteps of the successful spring and fall Evensongs, this year's Lessons and Carols will take place at 5:30 p.m. Listen to and sing along with St. Mary's Choir for a **festive introduction to the Christmas season** and its beautiful music.

Vision team to visit Quito, Ecuador!
