A WEEKLY REFLECTION: Prayer at the Dinner Table

Many of us incorporate a blessing at the beginning of our family meals. It is a simple and profound way to share our faith with our children. Nevertheless, it is a habit that can become stale and rote without some attention.

Recently, my children and I had dinner with my aunt and uncle. My uncle began the prayer by saying the blessing that he has said since he was a child, the same prayer I learned, and the one I have taught my children. As he began, the sense of familiarity and connection to all the people in our little tribe was powerful for me and, I hope, for my children. What he did next made their eyes pop up from their plates, though. He prayed for each of our family members by name, our whole wild lot of aunts, uncles, and cousins. Afterwards, he explained that he and my aunt do that every night - remember each of us by name in their nightly prayers. It left a lump in my throat to know how loved we are. I hope it made an impression on my children, too, to know that they are called out and named in love each night by people they only see every few months.

We're figuring out what we will add the end of our same table blessing. We haven't arrived at our stopping point, but here are some ideas we've tried...

- Asking each person to remember a special person or concern.
- Drawing from a bowl filled with slips of paper that have people or situations to be remembered in prayer.
- Using recent Christmas cards to remember a particular family in prayer each night.

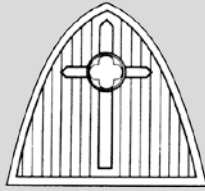
