Weezie Blanchard is pleased to **announce that Ryan Tibbetts will join the staff of St. Mary's as Director of Music beginning September 5.** Ryan has lived in Richmond since 2015 when his wife, Kate, accepted a faculty position in chemistry at Virginia Commonwealth University. He served most recently as interim organist and choirmaster at St. Thomas' Episcopal Church, and **he directs the Central Virginia Masterworks Chorale and the Richmond Concert Chorale.** The search committee was very impressed by both Ryan's musical talents and his enthusiasm as we seek to expand our already excellent music program. Ryan studied at Princeton University and the University of Delaware, and holds a Doctor of Music in choral conducting from the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music. **We look forward to introducing Ryan to the parish this fall.**

CHILDREN AND YOUTH

Sunday School starts next Sunday, September 10! Sunday School classes are offered for children ages 4 - 5th grade at 10 a.m. throughout the school year. The curriculum is lectionary based, meaning that each week the **kids learn about the Gospel story** (or a significant Old Testament story) that they will hear in worship. Any student in 8th grade (or above) is invited to join us in the St. Mary's confirmation process, which runs throughout the 2017-2018 school year. OUTREACH


