

Gleann Gollaith - Historic Home in Scotland

Gleann Gollaith (pronounced Glen Gully) is a 19th century listed house on the main street of historic Dornoch, described as the most beautiful street in Scotland. The house comprises a sitting room, dining room, dine-in kitchen and full bath with walk-in shower on the ground floor, and a king bedroom, twin bed room and full bath on the second floor. The house has recently been re-furbished. There is a small garden off of the kitchen.

Dornoch is best known for the Royal Dornoch Golf Club, ranked 5th in the world, and within walking distance of the house.

Education Equals Hope (E=H) is a 501(c)(3) founded by Episcopal missionary Cameron Vivanco that provides education for those living in desperate and difficult situations in Costa Rica, Ecuador, Haiti, Kenya, and Rwanda. In February 2017, St. Mary's explored potential international mission opportunities in partnership with Education Equals Hope in Quito, Ecuador. After a successful vision trip, St. Mary's assembled a team of five adults to take a mission trip in November 2017. Throughout the week, they developed lasting relationships with the parishioners of Emaus Episcopal Church and St. Mary's.

The goal in 2018 is to grow the team and continue to deepen the relationship between E=H, the Episcopal Church in Ecuador, and St. Mary's.
