A WEEKLY REFLECTION

1 John 3:18 *"Little children, let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action."*

Recently, I saw a good news story. As a mother and her young son were about to leave an outdoor concert, he began to randomly hug other concertgoers. While his mother kept close watch, the toddler hugged everyone nearby. Initially some people were taken by surprise, but before this little one was done, people were happily opening their arms to him.

Before children learn to speak, they satisfy curiosity and express affection through touch and sound. They cradle faces with tiny hands and give big, sloppy kisses even before they can pucker. They giggle and coo. They give hugs.

Could it be that instinct leads us to express our love in unmistakable ways before we are able to articulate it? Maybe the true love emanating from the heart of God is always looking for ways to express itself beyond words, in ways that draw people closer to one another and to God.

SPIRITUAL FORMATION AND ADULT EDUCATION

Men's Spiritual Practice continues this Tuesday, May 21 at 7:30 a.m. Bob Hetherington invites men of all ages to participate in a **one-hour time of silence, reflection, sharing, and prayer** that focuses on the Gospel reading for the following Sunday.

Lectionary Bible Study continues throughout the summer on Wednesdays at 10 a.m. in the Library. Everyone is welcome! Each Bible study session is led by University of Richmond Professor Frank Eakin and focuses on the Lectionary readings assigned for the following Sunday.

Women's Book Study is back this month and you aren't going to want to miss this! Gather on Tracey Ragsdale's porch on **Thursday, May 23 at 7:30 p.m.** to discuss *Tell Me More* by Kelly Corrigan. *Tell Me More: Stories about the 12 Hardest Things I am Learning to Say* helps open up real conversations about our daily lives, where messiness and sadness coexist with wonder and love and belly laughs. WORSHIP

There's a change this year to the summer schedule. It will begin after Pentecost on **Sunday, June 16** and until September, St. Mary's will worship at **10 a.m. in New St. Mary's**. Please note St. Mary's will **hold regular 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. Holy Eucharist services on Sundays, May 19 and 26, and June 2 and 9**. Morning Prayer returns on Sunday, June 23 at 10 a.m.


CHILDREN AND YOUTH
