FAITH & FILM WITH ELEANOR

As a follow up to the *Wonder of Years Lenten Forum Series*, St. Mary's is pleased to **offer a movie night** this week. Join the group this **Wednesday, May 29 at 6:30 p.m.** to watch and discuss the Danish movie *Babette's Feast* (English subtitles). David May referred to this movie during one of his Lenten sermons and **sometimes refers to it as the Fifth Gospel**. It addresses many issues, including aging, faith and change, which should spark some interesting conversation afterwards. **Movie snacks will be provided!**

Babette's Feast takes place in a remote 19th-century Danish village. The summary says, "two sisters lead a rigid life centered around their father, the local minister, and their church. Many years later - their father is now deceased - they take in French refugee, Babette Hersant, who agrees to work as their servant. After winning the lottery, Babette wants to repay the sisters for their kindness and offers to cook a French meal for them and their friends on the 100th anniversary of their father's birth. It **proves to be an eye-opening experience for everyone.**"

SPIRITUAL FORMATION AND ADULT EDUCATION

Men's Spiritual Practice continues this Tuesday, May 27 at 7:30 a.m. Bob Hetherington invites men of all ages to participate in a **one-hour time of silence, reflection, sharing, and prayer** that focuses on the Gospel reading for the following Sunday. There are only two more gatherings before they break for the Summer.

Lectionary Bible Study continues throughout the summer on Wednesdays at 10 a.m. in the Library. Everyone is welcome! Each Bible study session is led by University of Richmond Professor Frank Eakin and focuses on the Lectionary readings assigned for the following Sunday.

WORSHIP

There's a change this year to the summer schedule. Beginning after Pentecost **on Sunday, June 16** and until September, St. Mary's will worship at **10 a.m. in New St. Mary's**. Please note St. Mary's will **hold regular 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. Holy Eucharist services on Sundays, May 19 and 26, and June 2 and 9**. Morning Prayer returns on Sunday, June 23 at 10 a.m.

Do you speak another language? Pentecost is one of the church's great feast days. It tells the story of the **Holy Spirit descending onto the apostles** and other early followers of Jesus. They were suddenly empowered to proclaim the gospel and went out onto the streets. Not only did they preach with boldness and vigor, "**but by a miracle of the Holy Spirit they spoke in the native languages** of the people present." To represent this, **David wants to know if you speak another language.** If so, will you read part of the Gospel on Sunday, June 9? Contact **David May** with your language gifts or with any questions.

Wednesday Holy Eucharist with Prayers for Healing returns on Wednesday, June 12 at 12 p.m. in Little St. Mary's. Take time during your week to be fed by God's goodness and renewed in body, mind, and spirit. Also, this is a **perfect time and place to bring someone** who may need to be loved on by God's healing presence.

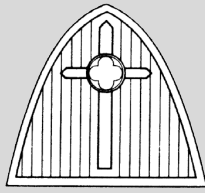
YOUTH
