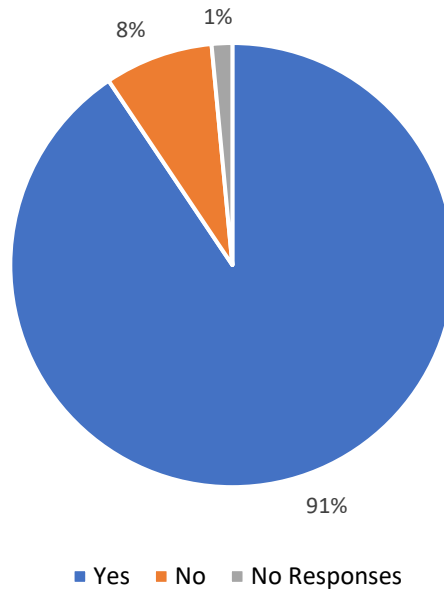

#### **Major Themes from the Additional Comments Section of the Survey:**

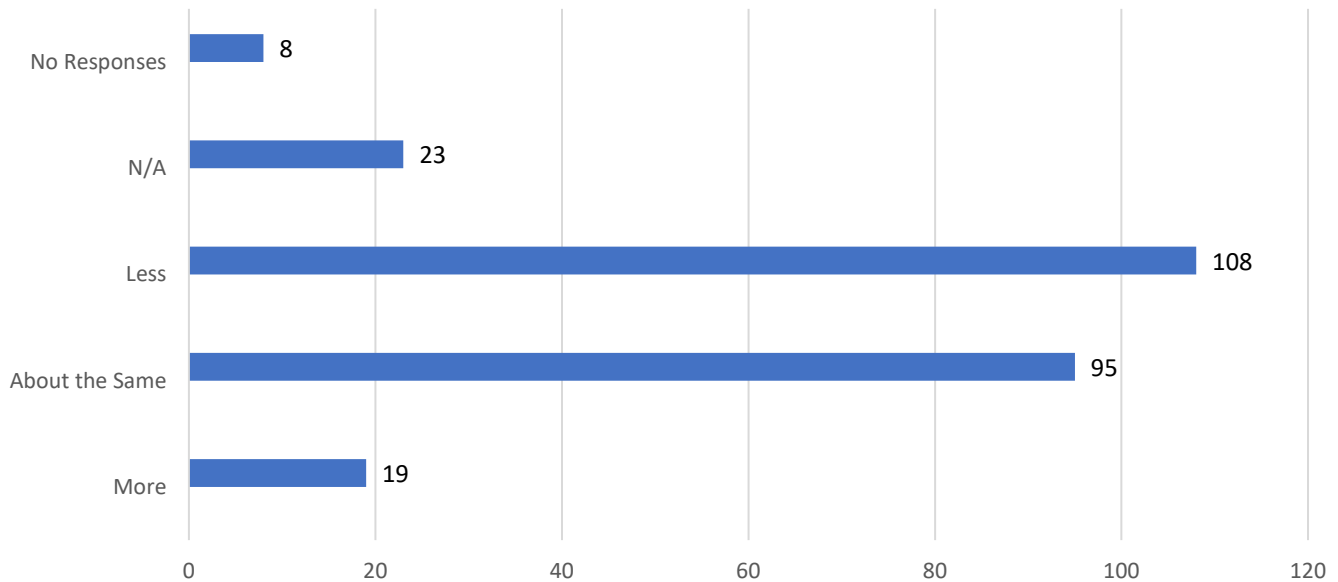

- ❖ On balance, a rather clear-eyed, realistic view is expressed that coming back together for in-person worship (with all the appropriate health safety protocols) need not be hurried. While a few voices stated a greater sense of urgency to opening up the church, a majority shared a desire to be cautious and judicious in coming back together.
- ❖ Even if we do have in-person worship with all the appropriate health safety protocols, we should continue livestreaming and/or recordings of services.

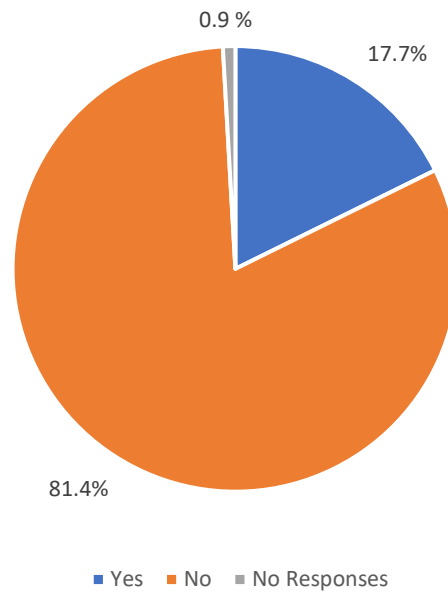
1. Have you participated in one of our online worship services in the last several weeks?



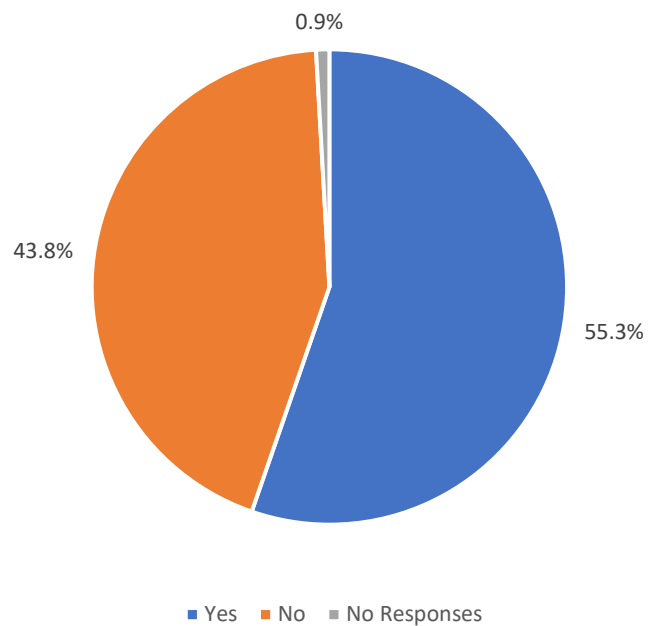
2. If you have participated in one of our online worship services, did you experience worship and God's presence more or less online compared to in-person worship?



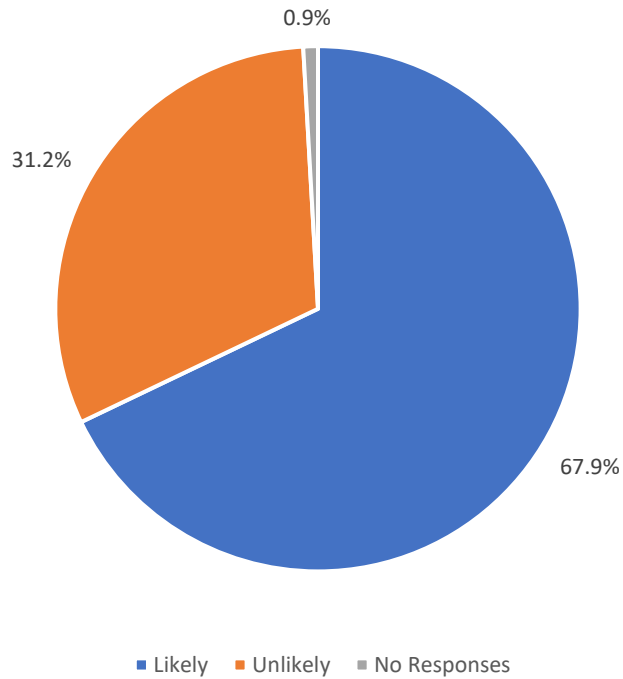
3. Have you participated in an online Children's Chapel, Men's Spiritual Practice, Youth Group hangout, or Lectionary Bible Study in the last several weeks?



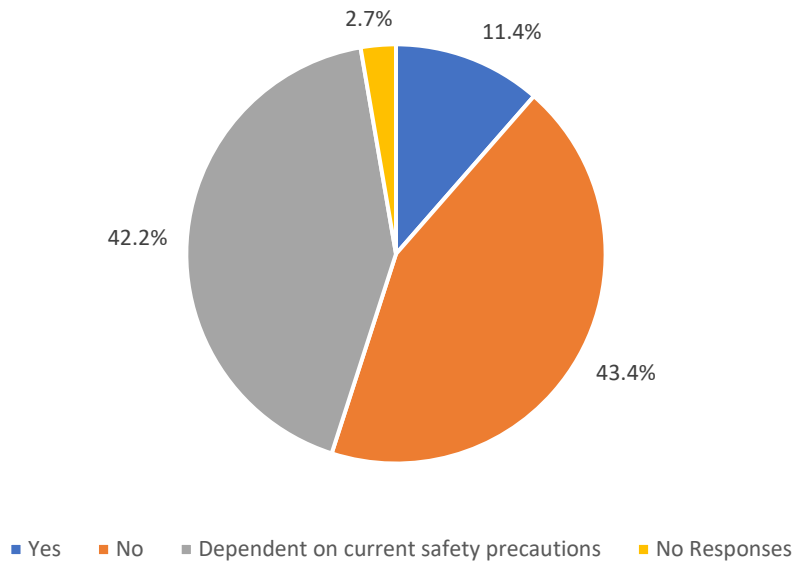
4. Are you in one of the groups that the CDC and health experts have identified as higher risk for serious health issues from covid-19?



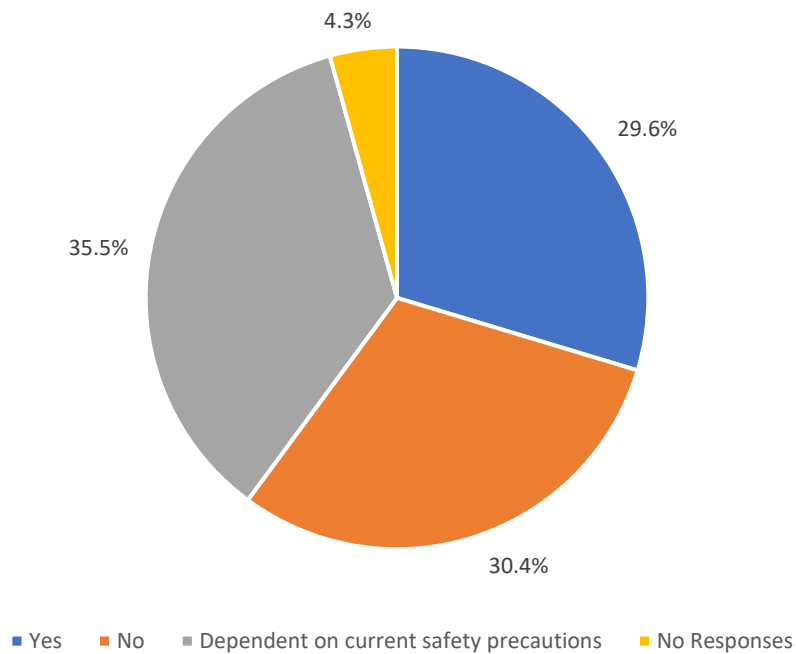
5. If we began offering in-person worship in the next months, how likely is it that you would attend?



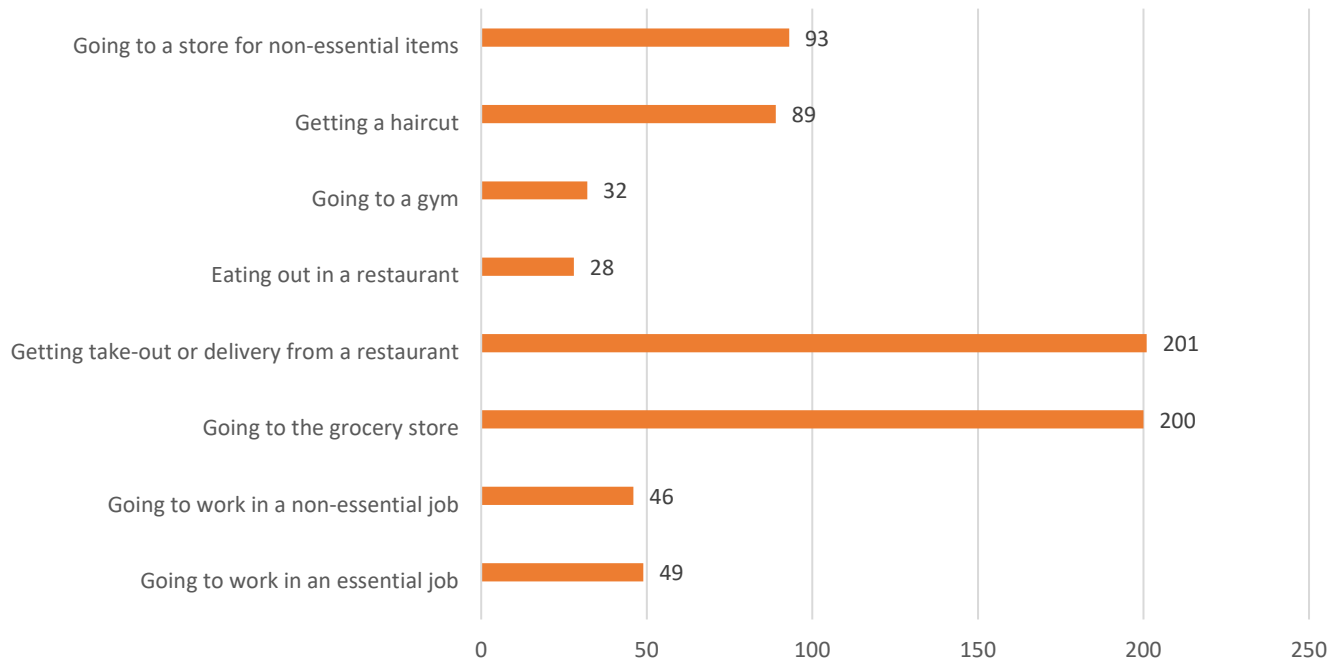
6. If we began offering in-person worship in the next months, would you be comfortable bringing a relative or close friend who is in one of the higher risk groups?



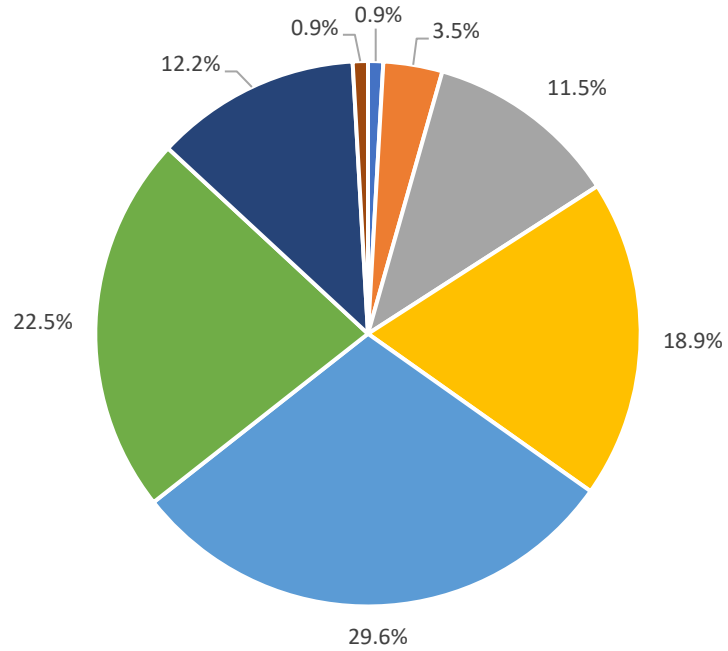
7. If we began offering in-person worship in the next months, would you be comfortable bringing a child or grandchild?
