

EVERY SUNDAY AT ST. MARY'S

9 a.m. - Holy Eucharist in Little St. Mary's
10 a.m. - Sunday School on the Nature Trail (or in classrooms as weather demands)
11 a.m. - Holy Eucharist or Morning Prayer in New St. Mary's with Children's Chapel

Nursery - 8:45 a.m.-12:15 p.m.

Nursery is offered for infants to 4-year-olds every Sunday. You are welcome to get your child during the passing of the peace and bring them to communion.

Sunday School - 10-11 a.m.

All children from 4-year-olds to 5th graders are invited to Sunday School at 10 a.m. We meet on the Nature Trail located behind the Youth Education Building to share the stories of our faith through conversation, games, art, and plenty of fun. In inclement weather we start in the Youth Education Building and proceed to classrooms.

Children's Chapel

During the 11 a.m. service, children are invited to follow the children's cross to the Block Room during the Gospel hymn. There, at Children's Chapel, they hear the Gospel story, talk about it, and sing together. They return to the service during the passing of the peace.
